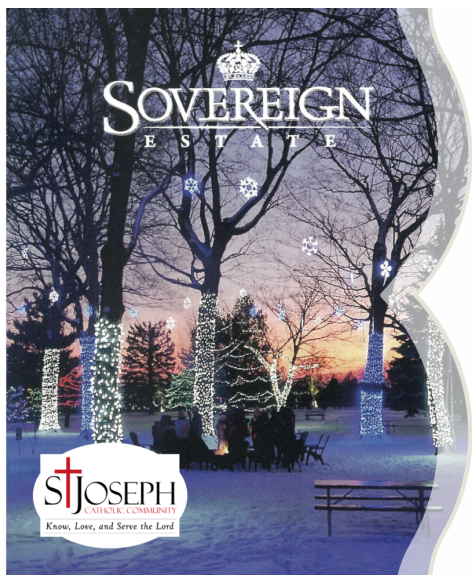

## *Examples of St. Ignatius' assumption of positive intent charism:*

- Giving others the benefit of the doubt
- Loving one another even in times of conflict
- Clarifying instead of reacting
- Focusing on shared goals
- Facilitating thoughtful conversations
- Unifying instead of dividing
- Addressing hard conversations to get to the root of the concern expressed
- Being dedicated to working toward a positive outcome
- Avoiding judgment about someone's concerns
- Assuming someone meant to cause good, rather than harm
- Communicating clearly around hot topics to reduce assumptions
- Examining own conscious to hear what the Lord is addressing through the other person
